Description of Project

GE served as the Prime Design Consultant providing professional engineering services for the 2.7-mile Shared Use Path along SR 30 (US 98) from Surf Road (CR 372) to south of Tower Road. This project primarily consisted of constructing a 10' wide shared use path along SR 30 (US 98/Coastal Highway) within the existing right-of-way, as well as a pedestrian bridge. Significant efforts were exercised to reduce impacts to the environment and trees while taking into account long term maintenance costs. The design for this shared use path incorporated the existing terrain and drainage patterns. A project specific sheet pile retaining wall was developed to cross saltwater marshes. ***This project earned a 2021 FTBA "Best in Construction" Award for Rural Project.***
