Description of Project

GE served as the Prime Design Consultant providing professional engineering services for the Shared Use Path along SR 30 (US 98/Coastal Highway) mostly within the existing right-of-way. There are eleven (11) parcels that will be affected by the trail and may require right-of-way acquisition. This project also included a section of sidewalk through the town of Panacea. Sidewalk was chosen to limit the potential for right-of-way impacts. Significant efforts were exercised to reduce impacts to the environment and trees while taking into account long term maintenance costs. The design for this shared use path incorporated the existing terrain and drainage patterns. A project specific sheet pile retaining wall was developed to cross wetlands for this project.
